SUNRISE 'HYUNDAI' PROMOTION
TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By entering the Sunrise 'Hyundai' Promotion, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

1. STANDARD TERMS

1.1 Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry.

2. WHO CAN ENTER?

2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all residents of Australia, over the age of 18 years, where the Channel Seven and affiliate broadcasting signals are received.

2.2 Employees and their immediate families and friends of Seven Network (Operations) Limited, Hyundai Motor Company Australia and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.

3. HOW TO ENTER

3.1 The competition commences on Monday 28 October 2019 at 05:30am (AEDT) and concludes on Thursday 12 December 2019 at 12:00pm (AEDT) ("the Competition Period") however, the eligible entry period for each weekly prize will commence and conclude on the following dates and times:

3.2 In order to enter, viewers must:

- a) Watch Sunrise ("the program") on the Seven Network during the Competition Period. Throughout the Competition Period there will be competition segments aired during the Program (or any replacement program broadcast in the Sunrise timeslot) which will disclose the competition question;
- b) Log onto the Sunrise website (www.sunrise.com.au) and register their full name, age, address (including state and postcode), email address, phone numbers and answer the competition question in 25 words or fewer and submit their entry.

3.3 Entries must be received by Thursday 12 December 2019 at 12.00pm (AEDT).

3.4 Winner must be eighteen (18) years of age or older.

3.6 The entry must be:

- (a) the original independent creation of the entrant; and
- (b) free from any claims, including but not restricted to copyright or trademark claims, by other parties.

5. **HOW TO WIN**

- 5.1 For each entry period there will be five (5) shortlisted entries selected each week which will be put forward to be judged by a panel of representatives appointed by the Promoter to be the most creative and/or original from the national pool received. Each entrant who has entered the competition over the Competition Period and registered all details in accordance with clause 3, between the competition dates and times as stated in clause 3.1 ("Qualifying Entrant") will be entered into the relevant competition following the close of entries for that period as stipulated in the table below. The competition is a game of skill and chance plays no part in determining the winner.

- 5.4 Each Friday from Friday 1 November 2019 to Friday 13 December 2019, Sunrise will announce the one (1) winner for each entry period live on the Sunrise program scheduled to be broadcast on the Seven Network between 05:30am to 09:00am (AEDT) Monday to Friday.
- 5.5 The Promoter reserves the right to re-judge in the event of a winner not claiming any Prize. If any Prize remains unclaimed or forfeited through ineligibility or otherwise, the Promoter will conduct a further judging, as required, at the same time and place as the original judging, three months and one week after the date of the original judging. - 6.6 Seven Network (Operations) Limited and the Sponsor assume no responsibility for any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of, entries, and reserves the right to take any action that may be available.
- 6.7 If for any reason this competition is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter or the Sponsor which corrupt or affect the administration security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this competition, the Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual who tampers with the entry process, take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition.
